Sermon: Celebrate from Death to Life / Speaker: Pastor Brian

1. *Deep six* is a nautical term used before the days of sonar indicating a depth of 6 fathoms (36 feet) under the surface of the water. If something was deep sixed, it was virtually impossible to retrieve, lost forever... gone to a watery grave. We all have moments, memories, mistakes that we try to deep six. Why do we do that? If you are willing, would you be able to share something that you have been deep sixing?
2. Read Acts 16:25-34. What are some things that jump out at you? Anything surprise you?
3. Why do you think the jailer was so afraid when he saw the prison doors open? In your opinion, what caused the jailer to "rush in" and "fall trembling" before Paul and Silas to ask about salvation?
4. The song "Drops in the Ocean" by Hawk Nelson is a love song from Jesus to you. If possible, listen to that song. Read the lyrics. If you need forgiven for something, confess that to God. He forgives you as far as the east is from the west.
5. If you have been baptized, share something about that day. What led you to it? How did you feel after? How has your life been since? The enemy will spend a lot of energy attacking those who pursue Christ. How have you fought back against Satan? If you have accepted Jesus as Lord and Savior and have never been baptized, what's holding you back? How can your group or our staff help you with that?
