1. Why did your parents give you the name that you have (named after a family member, celebrity, etc.)? If you could have any name in the world, which one would you choose?
2. Do you know what your name means? If not, look it up.
3. Using Exodus 3:1-15, we see how God seeks, speaks, saves, and sends through His interaction with Moses. How have you seen one or more of these "God actions" in your life?
4. The Lord told Moses to tell the Egyptians that I AM sent him. This put God in a league all His own. This speaks to His self-existence and self-sufficiency. How can this truth help you in your daily life? How can it help in times of trouble?

This Week's Challenge

Read John 14:1-6 . In these verses, Jesus uses a series of "I AM" statements to explain to His disciples that He and God are one. Utilize the power of Jesus in your life this week in your interactions with co-workers, your relationship with your children or spouse, decisions you need to make, or another area. Allow the Lord, through His Son Jesus, to change your outlook.
