1. Have you ever asked someone close to you to describe you as best they can? Was it accurate? Did you learn anything new?
2. Christian author and speaker Frank Turek said, "The reason so many people are easily talked out of Christianity is because they were never talked into it in the first place." How do you respond to that?
3. For the disciples, their knowledge of Jesus, and subsequent faith in Him, was a process that started with actual events that served as signs of who Jesus was. Today, we can only hear or read about those events. Should the fact that we were not eyewitnesses to His miracles affect our understanding of Him? Why or why not?
4. God allowed us to be closer to him by bringing His Son to earth, Immanuel (God with us). What has your relationship with Jesus taught you about God?

If Jesus were standing face-to-face with you and He asked you, "Who do you say I am?" what would you say? Pray that Jesus will grow your relationship with Him this week.
