- 1. What caught your attention in this week's message? Was there something you had never heard before or something you had a question about?
- 2. When have you recently been surprised by God? Maybe in a season of disappointment or in a time of excitement. What happened? How did it impact you?
- 3. If you were asking people today what they would be looking for in a Messiah, what might you hear?
- 4. Read Luke 24:13-33 again.
 - What do you think the conversation was like between the two men?
 - Why do you think Jesus was slow to reveal Himself to them?
 - What is significant in the way Jesus chose to reveal Himself?
- 5. For further study, read Luke 24:36-53 when Jesus appeared to the disciples.
 - Jesus told the disciples many times that He would die and be raised three days later. Why did the disciples think they saw a ghost?
 - How did Jesus reveal Himself to them?
 - In that encounter, when did the disciples finally believe that Jesus had been raised from the dead?
- 6. Jesus is present with you even when you don't recognize it.
 - How have you found that to be true in your life?
 - Are you in a season, right now, where it's hard to recognize Christ's presence?
- 7. Do you sense that God is prompting you to respond in some way to this message? If so, how?

Pray about it: Meditate on God's Word (Luke 24:13-33) and this week's message.

Adoration: What can I praise God for in light of what this teaches me?

Confession: What sin can I confess because of what this teaches me?

Thanksgiving: What can I thank God for in light of what He has done?

Supplication: What do I need to ask of God in order to grow in light of this?
