- 2. What can we learn about the Canaanite woman? What can we learn about her attitude toward Jesus?
- 3. Why do you think Jesus did not reply to the woman after her initial request?
 - How did the disciples respond to Jesus' silence?
 - Does this remind you of anything from a previous study? See Matt. 14
- 4. What stands out in the woman's attitude and response to Jesus in verse 25?
- 5. In our study this morning, we learned that there are two Greek words for dogs, kyon and *kynarion*.
 - Which one was Jesus using and how did it apply to the woman?
 - Considering the meaning of these two words, what was the significance of Jesus' response?
- 6. One of our key takeaways today is that God will go out of His way to take care of us.
 - Does that encourage you? If so, in what way?
- God is faithful and faithful to His word. Read the following verses and discuss what they say about God and His faithfulness. Exodus 34:6-7, Psalm 36:5, 2 Thessalonians 3:3, 2 Timothy 2:11-13, Hebrews 13:8, 1 John 1:9
- 8. When was the last time you simply prayed, "Lord, help me?" Is that a request you need to be asking right now?
