- 6. How do you deal with physical, spiritual, and cultural attacks?
- 7. How has God answered your prayers and given you victory over physical, spiritual, and cultural attacks?
- 8. Read the following passages: Psalm 34:19, Proverbs 24:10, 2 Corinthians 4:8-9, 1 Peter 5:10. How do these verses encourage us and help us in times of trouble?
- 9. Be in continual prayer for strength and guidance from the Holy Spirit in this area. Do not forget to put on the Full Armor of God daily (Ephesians 6:10-18).

### Pray about it: Meditate on God's Word (Nehemiah 4) and this week's message.

Adoration: What can I praise God for in light of what this teaches me?

Confession: What sin can I confess because of what this teaches me?

Thanksgiving: What can I thank God for in light of what he has done?
