- 7. How do you respond to changes in plans or unexpected directions from God? Share an example of a time when flexibility helped you grow in your faith.
- 8. How has the Bible provided guidance and reassurance in your life? Can you share a specific verse or passage that has been particularly meaningful to you recently?
- 9. Now that Christmas has passed, what steps can you take to keep the spirit and message of Christmas alive in your heart and actions throughout the year?
