

	: Gk. <i>euangelion</i> – good news, God's gospel (not Paul's)
	: Gk. <i>charis</i> – God's unmerited (undeserved) favor to unworthy people <u>G</u> od's <u>R</u> iches <u>A</u> t <u>C</u> hrist's <u>E</u> xpense
	: Gk. <i>agios</i> – holy one, set apart unto the Lord Every believer in Jesus
	: Gk. <i>dynamis</i> – dynamite, strength and ability
	: Gk. <i>pistis</i> - belief, trust, and reliance on God The focus of the gospel is an obedience-producing faith
