Sermon Talks

1. What stood out to you most from the sermon or the passage in Luke 19:28–44?
2. Have you ever had a moment when God asked you to do something that didn't make sense at the time? How did you respond?
3. Jesus told the disciples to say, "The Lord needs it." What's something in your life you think the Lord might be saying that about right now?
4. The people laid down their cloaks for Jesus. What "cloak"—identity, comfort, pride, fear—do you feel Jesus is asking you to lay down?
5. Why do you think we tend to hold onto things Jesus is asking us to surrender? What are we afraid of losing?
6. In what ways do we worship safely or silently today, and what might bold, public worship look like in our context?
7. Jesus wept over Jerusalem because they didn't recognize their moment. What might it look like for someone today to miss their "day of visitation" from God?
8. What are signs that someone is going through the motions spiritually? How can we move from surface-level faith to a deeper relationship?
9. What's one thing you feel God is asking you to lay down this week? How can this group support you in taking that step?
10. If Jesus walked into our church or community today, what might make Him weep? What do you think would bring Him joy?

Pray about it: Meditate on God's Word (Luke 19:28-44) and this week's message.

Adoration: What can I praise God for in light of what this teaches me?

Confession: What sin can I confess because of what this teaches me?

Thanksgiving: What can I thank God for in light of what he has done?

Supplication: What do I need to ask of God in order to grow in light of this?
