- 1. Read Luke 2 to start your study time.
- 2. What did you learn about the manger today that you may not have known before?
- 3. Why is it so hard to give God our mess? Why do so many people hold onto it?
- 4. Why is it so hard to trust? Why do we make it so hard to trust God?
- 5. In what way was the manger a sign for the shepherds?
- 6. Share some examples of when you have seen God's hand in your life?
- 7. What are steps that we can take to seek an attitude of praise?
- 8. Twice in the book of Luke, we see the Greek word for pleased (*eudokia*). One is in Luke 2:14, the other is in Luke 10:21. Read Luke 10:21. What did Jesus mean when He said, "...because you have hidden these things from the wise and learned, and revealed them to little children (babes)?"
- 9. The manger was a part of God's plan to lead us to the cross. What are some of the parallels between the fact that Jesus was born in a manger and that He died on a cross?
- 10. Read Philippians 2:5-11. What do these verses say about the humility of our Savior? What is God's desired response from us? See verses 10 and 11.
- 11. What is the Good News? What are some ways that we can share it?
- 12. Allow the Holy Spirit to guide you in a time of prayer.
