Sermon Talks

1. Read Daniel 2:1-30 as you prepare to work through the sermon talks.
2. What kind of temptations have you faced this week? Have you been able to overcome them? If so, how?
3. Have you had an opportunity to impact someone for Jesus this week? If so, talk about it.
4. How does the wise men's failure to explain and interpret King Nebuchadnezzar's dream illustrate the limits of human wisdom and religion? What does their response in verse 11 reveal about their view of God?
5. What was Daniel's immediate reaction when he heard the death decree? Why do you think he sought out Hananiah, Mishael, and Azariah to pray with him?
6. Real trust in God is contagious. Can you think of a time where your faith in God empowered someone else to trust God?
7. Daniel had every right to make it about himself, but he chose not (verses 29-30). What does that say about his character? Why is it so hard to be 'others' focused?
8. God works "behind the scenes" in this story. What do you learn about God? What do you learn about how to respond to God?
9. Allow the Holy Spirit to guide you in a time of prayer. Begin by praising God for who He is and what He has done in your life.

Pray about it: Meditate on God's Word (Daniel 2:1-30) and this week's message.

Adoration: What can I praise God for in light of what this teaches me?

Confession: What sin can I confess because of what this teaches me?

Thanksgiving: What can I thank God for in light of what he has done?

Supplication: What do I need to ask of God in order to grow in light of this?
