4. How can we expect to be persecuted for our faith? Is there an example in your life?
5. Read John 15:20, 2 Timothy 3:12, and 1 Peter 4:12. What do these verses say about the reality of persecution?
6. Read Matthew 5:44, Romans 12:14, and 1 Peter 4:19. What direction do these verses give us in responding to persecution?
7. How does Daniel's story encourage you to stay faithful when your faith is costly or risky?
8. How can prayer influence us when it comes to trusting God?
9. What are ways that Daniel maintained his integrity no matter what was going on around him? What are steps we can take to do the same?
10. How did Darius show his loyalty to Daniel? Have you been blessed with a loyal friend in times of difficulty? Explain.
11. Daniel continually gave the credit for his success and his victories to God. What does "giving all the credit to God" actually look like in your daily work or home life?
12. Reread Daniel 6:26-28. In what way do we see God's sovereignty through this story?
13. Allow the Holy Spirit to guide you in a time of prayer. Begin by praising God for who He is and what He has done in your life.
